**COMPLIANCE WITH THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY'S ROHS DIRECTIVE
(EC 2002/95/EC)**

To Whom It May Concern,

With reference to compliance of the EC directives WEEE (2002/96/EC) and RoHS (2002/95/EC), we wish to advise you that the products manufactured and supplied by NOSHOK, Inc. fall in an exemption of the WEEE directive. This exemption as per annex 1A of the WEEE directive encompasses **Monitoring and Control Instruments. Therefore, the bans on materials described in Chapter 4.1 of the RoHS directive do not apply to our products.**

It is the objective of this exemption to give manufacturers and users the opportunity to test the long-term reliability of compliant materials, thus minimizing the failure risk for Monitoring and Control Instruments.

Regardless of the exemption, our goal is that all NOSHOK products meet and/or exceed the limitations of harmful substances. For this reason, NOSHOK has set up a RoHS project team, whose goal is to identify and qualify sustainable production methods and components that meet the material requirements of RoHS.
